FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAM

*First Communion &
Reconciliation*

Preparation Classes 2026 Classes are for children wishing to make their First Holy Communion at St Swithun's. The classes are aimed at children in Yrs 3-5 Requirements: 1. A Baptism certificate (if not baptised at St Swithun's or St Thomas More) 2. Regular Sunday Mass attendance. Classes for 2026 will start in January 2026. Your involvement in the preparation of your children for First Holy Communion is paramount. The parish 'helps', but does not replace your part in the process of leading your children in the development of their faith, through the development and example of your own. As part of their preparation your child will be prepared for, and invited to make their First Reconciliation: "Children must go to the sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving Holy Communion for the first time" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1457). Please speak to Father Wojciech to register your child.

Gift card fraud is an increasingly common way of tricking victims into purchasing gift cards and sharing their details, leading to financial loss. The Diocese and its clergy will never ask for money, gift cards, vouchers, or personal details by email, text message, or social media. If you receive a message of this kind, do not respond and do not send any money. Please report it to your parish office or to the Diocese communications team so that we can alert others.

THE FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. With it, the Christmas Season comes to an end. In the Liturgy, we do a fast forward of thirty years, to when as a man grown up, Jesus begins His Public Ministry. The first event of his public ministry was His baptism in the River Jordan by John. As the Gospel tells, it was a revelation of the Blessed Trinity: *the Spirit descended like a dove* and the Father's voice rang out: *This is my Son, the Beloved*. The feast makes us think about the importance of the beautiful Sacrament of Baptism. Jesus, of course, did not need to be baptised; the reason He submitted to John's Baptism and went down into the waters was for us and for our salvation: to make holy the waters of baptism. To baptise means to immerse in water. The one baptised is immersed into the death of Christ in order to rise with Him as a new creation. As the *Catechism* says, baptism is the gateway to life in the Spirit. It cleanses us of Original Sin, makes us disciples of Christ, members of His Church and fills us with the eternal life of the Trinity. It makes us holy. It's an amazing gift, a living gift that needs constant nurture. God wants everyone to be saved and Baptism is necessary for salvation. It is the Sacrament of Faith. Faith - how to rouse it, strengthen it, hand it on, spread it?

You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you. In Mass next Sunday, let us pray for all to be baptised during 2026, especially all the adults in our RCIA programmes across the Diocese. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to descend upon many with the gift of faith, that they will welcome it. Let us pray for ourselves, that during the Holy Year we will become more holy, filled with the joy of the Gospel.
